Registration Information

The 2008 registration fee is \$175 per person plus sales tax. The advisor and chaperon fee is \$140 plus sales tax. Full payment is required with your registration form. VISA, MasterCard, American Express and checks are accepted.

Registration fees include participation in all sessions and activities including meals, lodging, supplies and related program costs. Tax can be omitted by using a school check for payment.

Registration forms must be postmarked no later than Monday, June 2, 2008. Early registration is highly recommended. Space is limited and will be reserved on a first-come, first-serve basis.

Advisor Benefit

An advisor or approved chaperon who brings five or more paying students from the same chapter to the same conference will have free registration.

Refund Policy

If you find you must cancel your reservation, please request a refund in writing to the Executive Director of the Florida FFA Foundation. A \$25 processing fee will be deducted from your refund. Absolutely no refunds after June 6, 2008. Substitutions for another registrant from the same school will be allowed if the registration fee was paid with a school check.
